

Physical Therapy Advisory Committee
Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on December 2, 2016, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this specially scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 29, 2016, and posted on the Board's website on November 30, 2016. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on November 30, 2016 at 10:15 a.m.

In light of the absence of David Haynes, Chair, Randy Titony, Vice-Chair, presided over this meeting.

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Titony called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Ball moved to approve the minutes of October 21, 2016, as written. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Titony re-ordered the personal appearances in order to accommodate those applicants appearing via web video.

CALLIE CURNUTT appeared via web video in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant and her request to sit for the national exam a third time with special accommodations of a special room and additional time. Ms. Curnutt advised the Committee that she did not receive special accommodations during school. She believes she has a good grasp of the material and is prepared to sit and pass the exam at this time. Mr. Jekel moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file and to grant permission

for her to sit for the national exam a third time with special accommodations of a special room and additional time. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

REO REA appeared via web video in support of his application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure and request to sit for the national exam a third time. Mr. Rea stated he believes he has a good grasp of where his deficiencies lie and will successfully pass the exam on the third attempt. Following Committee discussion, Mr. Jekel moved to recommend granting permission for the applicant to sit for the national exam a third time and approval of the application pending completion of the file. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

STEPHEN BULLARD appeared in support of his application for re-entry of Physical Therapist licensure. Ms. Mitchell stated he was initially licensed in May of '07 and that license expired in 2014. During that time, Mr. Bullard's required continuing education units ("CEUs") for the 2010-2011 compliance period were late and he was assigned double CEUs for the 2012-2013 compliance period which were not completed. Applicant stated he did not renew his license in 2014 due to family illness. He is interested in working in an acute-care setting. Mr. Bullard further explained that he was brought up on charges for animal abuse, which he initially lied about on his renewal application, but those charges have been expunged. Applicant stated he has been doing construction and farm work since his license expired.

The Committee discussed that Applicant was lacking the double CEUs required for 2012-2013 (80 hours total) and for the 2014-2015 compliance cycle he needs 40. Mr. Bullard stated he has sent in proof of 37 CEUs obtained to Licensing. Ms. Mitchell stated she had no record of having received those 37 CEUs. Upon further discussion, Ms. Wythe stated the applicant could be required to complete the CEUs previously required. Upon further investigation, the 37 CEUs were located and presented to the Committee for its review.

Ms. Ball moved to recommend requiring Mr. Bullard to complete his continuing education requirements for the compliance periods 2012-2013 and 2014-2015 for a total of 120 hours which includes 6 hours of ethics and to appear before the Committee upon completion of his outstanding continuing education requirements. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

LISA BURCH appeared in support of her application for Physical Therapist licensure. Ms. Burch has been out of practice since 1999. She appeared at the October 2016 Committee meeting and, pursuant to the Committee's instructions, she took Federation of State Board of Physical Therapy Practice Exam and Assessment Tool ("PEAT") and she is here today with the results. She did not study before she took the PEAT because she really wanted to see where her weaknesses were so she could direct her continuing education courses in that direction. She would like to work in acute care. Ms. Davis explained some of the challenges now facing acute-care therapists. Applicant's PEAT scores did not put her at a place where the Committee is comfortable granting a temporary license at this time. Ms. Davis moved to recommend tabling this application pending a personal appearance before the Committee once Applicant's Federation of State Board of Physical Therapy Practice Exam and Assessment Tool has reached a scaled score of 600 or above and that any continuing education units ("CEUs") obtained in the

interim will be applied to her required CEU total. Ms. Ball seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

BARBARA FLACK appeared in support of her re-entry for Physical Therapist licensure. She last practiced in 2001 and her license expired in 2004 in Arizona. Ms. Flack appeared before the Committee in October of 2016 and was directed at that time to complete the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Practice Review Tool (“PRT”) as well as obtain a letter from a potential supervisor and provide that information to the Committee for its review at today’s meeting. Ms. Flack provided her scores for the Option Tool, but did not provide a letter from a potential supervisor. She stated she is interested in outpatient orthopedic, but has had difficulty finding someone to supervise her in outpatient orthopedics. She has spoken with the Air Force and the Veteran’s Administration regarding employment. Regarding her Option Tool scores, the applicant stated she feels should focus on outpatient orthopedic exams and treatment. She holds a Master’s degree in Physical Therapy.

Following Committee discussion, Ms. Ball moved to recommend approval of a temporary license to run for one year pending completion of the file including 12 months at 22 days per month of direct supervision and obtaining a passing score on the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Practice Review Tool. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. *The Board Secretary will approve Applicant’s supervisor.*

TAYLOR HOPE LEWIS appeared in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant and request to sit for the national exam a third time. She provided her study plan for Committee review. Ms. Lewis stated she has taken examination prep courses which she began in the end of October. She said she believes her biggest problem is second-guessing herself when she tests. Ms. Lewis stated she uses the O’Sullivan books in addition to her school text books for studying purposes and she feels ready to sit for her exam at this time. Ms. Ball moved to recommend allowing Ms. Lewis to sit for the national exam a third time and approve her application pending completion of the file. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

MICHAEL LOPEZ appeared in support of his application for Physical Therapist Assistant and request to sit for the national exam a third time with special accommodations of time and a half and a paper test. He provided his study plan for Committee review and stated he did not receive special accommodations in school. Mr. Lopez explained his father was murdered two days before school started and he had a lot of anxiety in his final year of school but is working through that. Ms. Ball moved to recommend allowing Mr. Lopez to sit for the national exam a third time with special accommodations of time and a half and a paper test and approving his application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure pending completion of the file. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

CYNTHIA PIERCE appeared in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant and request to sit for the national exam a third time. Ms. Pierce stated that when she took the exam previously she had a lot going on personally and she also has test anxiety. The Committee told Ms. Pierce that her study guide as presented looked a little vague. She was advised to read her textbooks in preparation for the exam. Ms. Pierce would like to sit for the exam in April of 2017. Ms. Ball moved to recommend allowing Ms. Pierce to sit for the national exam a third time and approving her application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure

pending completion of the file. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

A brief recess was taken.

Upon reconvening, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure.

Ms. Davis moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for Physical Therapist licensure. Mr. Jekel seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next the Committee heard from Teresa Mitchell, Licensing Director, as she led a brief orientation regarding the current processing of the Form 5. She advised the Committee that group members need to be listed on the Form 5. Reji Varghese, Deputy Director, stated they are in the process of revising the Form 5 and will bring it before the Committee when it is completed. Mr. Titony stated he has a couple of ideas that have to do with the database and he will set up a meeting with Teresa.

Mr. Varghese then gave a brief update on the status of electronic review of continuing education courses. He stated the first phase is complete but there are changes that need to be made so he needs to take it back to the programmer. Mr. Varghese then gave a brief orientation of the submission portal portion. He stated he would email the portal form to the Committee for their review. The Committee agreed that the agenda and other information could be attached to the form rather than typed in to the form. One blank text box for "Further Explanation" will be provided. Mr. Varghese stated his goal is for this module to go live in the next couple of weeks. He reminded the Committee that this is the first phase only. Ms. Davis recommended having an auto population in the program feature to make it more convenient for ongoing CEU reporting and reviewing. Mr. Varghese said he would speak with the programmer and see if this can be incorporated into the program. Mr. Varghese also said this might be a process that can be taken care of in-house.

Ms. Davis moved to approve all CEUs pursuant to committee recommendations reviewed prior to this meeting that are contained in the box (**Attachment #1**) and on the list attached hereto (**Attachment #2**). Ms. Ball seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
